Racing:

- We have planned for a fun, relaxed tournament planned. There are 60 races so we will all have to be extra prompt.
- We will have **2 minute warm ups** - both Saturday and Sunday for every teams' first race.

1 minute warm ups will occur as soon as all teams have had their 2 minute warm up.

Texas Twisters will be hosting an Easter Egg Hunt for the children on Sunday during lunch!!

*The Easter eggs will be hidden during the first 5 – 6 minutes of the lunch while our kids will be in the kitchen area. They will then be called out to go hunt for eggs! Youngest kids will get a few minutes head start over the older kids. The eggs will be hidden in the showbarn only. No eggs will be hidden outside. They will be located anywhere **except** in the racing ring, on top of or near dog crates or personal items such as purses or dog equipment bags.*

These rules will be reviewed to everyone during the captain's meeting on Sunday.

Tournament Points:

The winner of each heat will receive one tournament point, and the winner of the majority of heats in a race will be awarded an additional two bonus points regardless of format.

Heats ending in a tie will result in each team receiving $\frac{1}{2}$ of a tournament point.

If neither team wins the majority of heats, there will not be an extra heat ran, but both teams will split the 2 additional bonus points.

If neither team wins the majority of heats because of a double loss in one of the heats, there will not be an extra heat ran and neither team will receive bonus points.

Division Tie Breakers:

1. Results of head to head competition at the heat level.
2. Fastest legal time in head to head competition.
3. Fastest legal time in the division competition.
3. Toss of a coin.

Crating: Crating map is up. .

Parking: Parking is allowed on the north, east and south sides of the building. Please do not block off any of the bay doors or regular doors

Poop Area: The poop area will be located just to the south and west of the building in the grassy areas.
